

TRIAGE

Standiford Veterinary Center and 24 hour Emergency
Veterinary Technicians will prioritize patients based on the
severity of condition

Patients will be seen by a Veterinarian in order of priority.
There may be delays for priority 2 and priority 3 patients.



PRIORITY 1

May survive if life saving measures are applied

EXAMPLE:

- Poisoning
- Collapse
- Snake Bite
- Bloat (GDV)
- Heat Stroke
- Open Fracture
- Actively Seizuring
- Allergic Reactions
- Traffic Accident
- Difficulty Breathing
- Excessive Bleeding
- Paralysis



PRIORITY 2

Likely to survive if care is given within hours

EXAMPLE:

- Closed Fractures
- Diarrhea
- Acute vomiting
- Bowel Obstruction
- Urinary Issues
- Birthing Difficulties



PRIORITY 3

EXAMPLE:

- Skin Conditions
- Lameness
- Sore eyes/ears
- Minor wounds
- Abscesses
- Chronic Diseases
